-  Just walk away from the person when you're done talking
-  Wait for the person to stop talking
-  Say, "Okay, I'll talk to you later"
-  Turn away and say nothing
-  Say, "I'm done with this conversation now"
-  Say, "Nice talking with you"
-  Start up a new conversation about a new topic
-  Look at them and smile
